CALVES—Leading


All calves must have a halter. Most farm trading stores or Vets sell halters and leads. You may want to erect a simple ring (See figure below), put in pegs and mark the course to practice. A little practice daily is the best idea.

The calf is lead anticlockwise around the following course:

Have the calf on your right side. Hold the lead approximately 10-20cm away from the calf's head with the right hand fingers upwards. Allow for a loop between the hands, and with the left hand hold the rope, fingers facing down.

The following actions will be penalised:

- 1. Releasing the right hand grip upon the rope at any time.
- 2. Touching the calf with the hand at any time during the competition
- 3. Hitting the calf with anything
- 4. Jerking on the collar
- 5. Stopping except as required by the judge, or when the calf wishes to relieve itself.
